## I. INTRODUCTION

An XML sitemap is a file that acts as the roadmap of your website that leads Google to all your important pages.

"**Dynamic Google Sitemap**" module allows you to generate and customize a sitemap automatically, even very large sitemaps (up to million URLs) in a fast and memory-efficient way.


\*"**Dynamic Google Sitemap**" is compatible with PrestaShop 1.6.x, 1.7.x and PrestaShop 8.x

## II. INSTALLATION

- Navigate to "**Modules / Modules Manager**" > click on "**Upload a module / Select file**".
- Select the module file "**etsdynamicsitemap.zip**" from your computer then click on "**Open**" to install.
- Click on "**Configure**" button of the module you just installed to open the module's configuration page.

## III. CONFIGURATION

From your installed module list (located at "**Modules/Module Manager**"), find "**Dynamic Sitemap**" then click on the "**Configure**" button to open its configuration page.



- **Enable sitemaps:** turn on this option to enable the dynamic sitemap feature for your site.
- **Primary sitemap:** this is a dynamic sitemap XML file containing sub sitemaps to all your pages. You can submit this sitemap to Google and other search engines (Bing, Baidu, etc.).





- **Sitemap by languages:** if your website is using multiple languages, our module will also generate the sitemap for each available language.
- **Priority:** the number values that signal the importance of individual pages in the website to Google and other search engines.



- **Frequency:** specify how often your site content changes to re-update sitemap.



- **Pages to include in sitemap:** select the pages you want to include in sitemap file.
- **Number of products per page in sitemap pagination:** specify the number of products will be displayed per sitemap page. If you leave this field blank, all products will be displayed in the same page.

After configuring your dynamic sitemap, click on **“Save”** button to save your changes.
