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## I. WELCOME

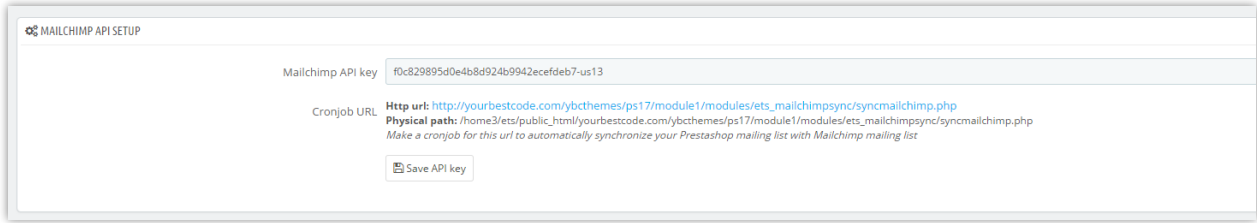
This module is compatible with Prestashop 1.5.x – 8.x

## II. INSTALLATION

- Navigate to “**Modules / Modules Manager**” > click on “**Upload a module / Select file**”.
- Select the module file “**ets\_mailchimpsync**” from your computer then click on “**Open**” to install.
- Click on “**Configure**” button of the module you just installed to open the module’s configuration page.

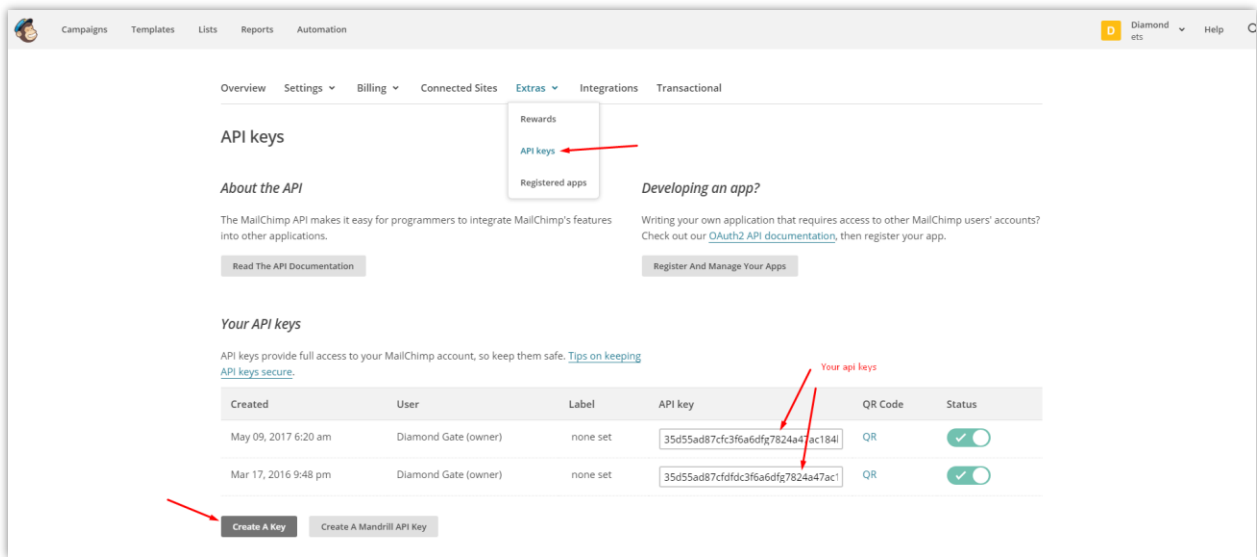
## III. CONFIGURATION

### 1. MAILCHIMP API SETUP



**\* Note:**

- In order to create a Mailchimp API key, you need to login to your Mailchimp account (<https://login.mailchimp.com>) then navigate to your account profile page, under “Extras” tab select “API keys” and finally click on “Create A Key”



- Click on the “Http url” to manually synchronize all mailing lists with Mailchimp

## 2. WEBHOOK

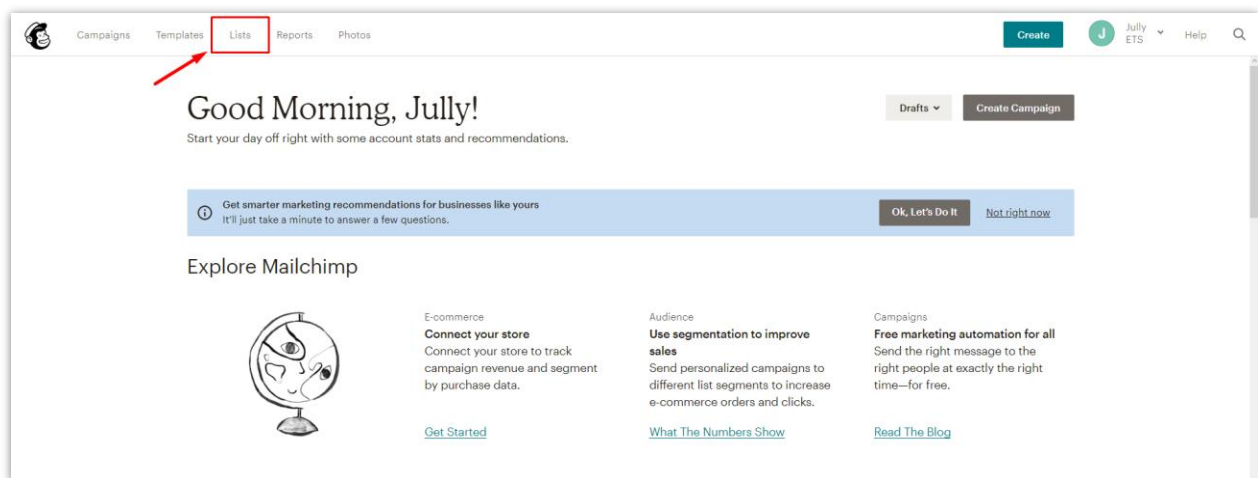
Webhooks allow you to collect information about events as they happen in near real-time. Once you provide a URL and select the type of information that you want to receive, Mailchimp'll send that data to you as the events take place.

### Configuring Webhooks

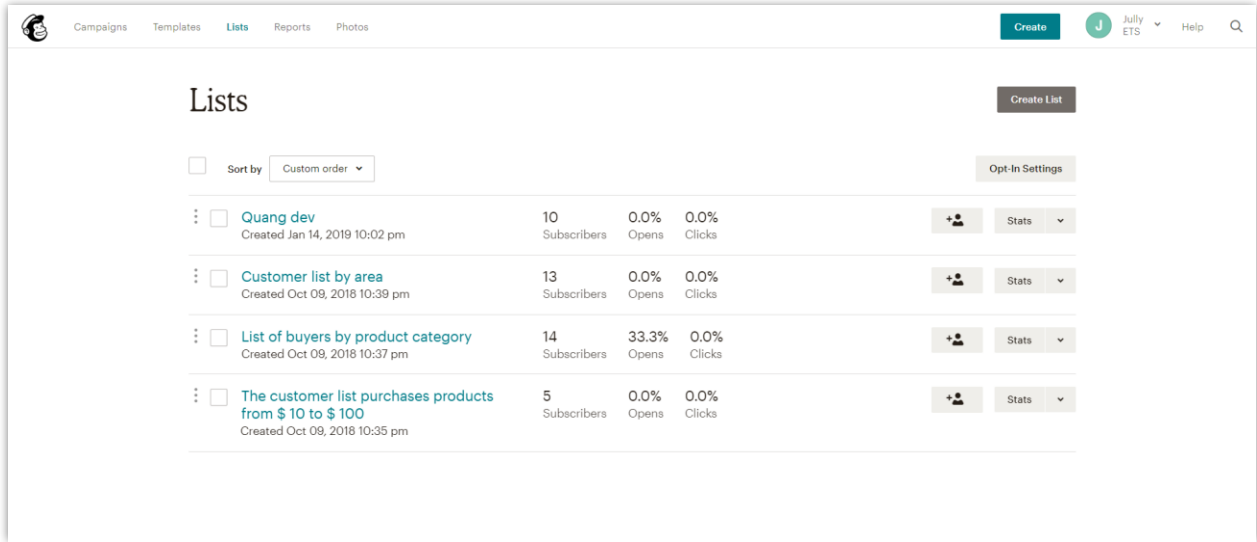
Webhooks can be created and managed in your Mailchimp account. To create a webhook in Mailchimp:

**Step 1:** Log in to your Mailchimp account.

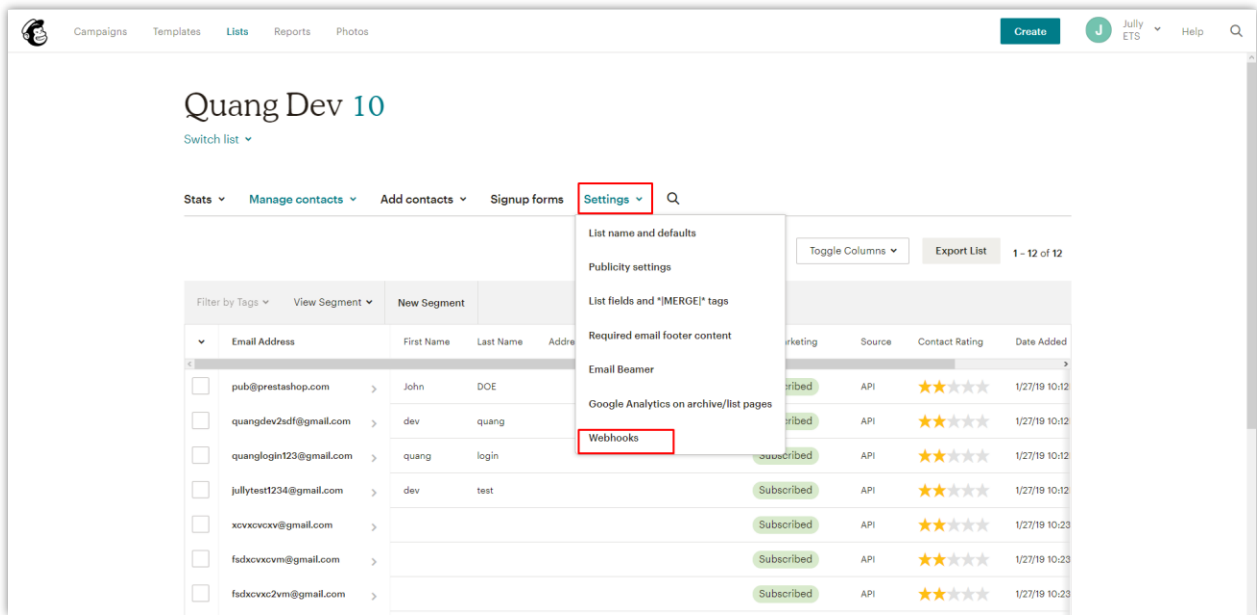
**Step 2:** Navigate to your Lists



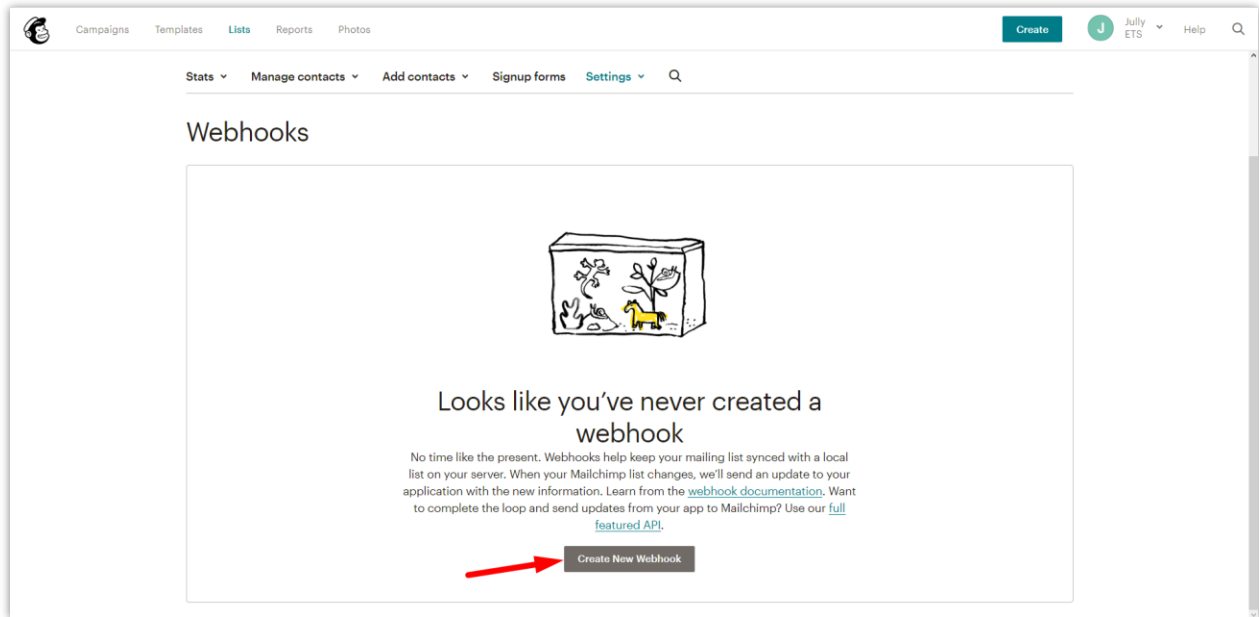
**Step 3:** Choose the list that you wish to configure



**Step 4:** Click the Settings menu option, then choose Webhooks



**Step 5:** Click "Create New Webhook"



Enter the callback URL as the structure below:

*[{your\\_site\\_URL}/modulemodule/ets\\_mailchimpsync/apilisten?key={your\\_API\\_key}](#)*

Select the types of update you want Mailchimp to send then click Save.

## Create new webhook

- Via the API





- You can edit or delete a mailing list by clicking on the respective buttons
- Click on “SYNC” buttons to manually synchronize a mailing list with the mailing list on your Mailchimp account
- Click on “Export to CSV” to export the list to a CSV file if you would like to download the list

## 5. SETUP CRONJOB FOR AUTO SYNCHRONIZATION

After you have installed the module and created your first mailing lists you can now manually synchronize your mailing lists with Mailchimp however you can also do the synchronization automatically by setting up cronjob for the given URL.
