## II. INTRODUCTION

Your multi-language PrestaShop store is required to meet the different needs of your customers from many countries worldwide. With **“Multi-language product images”**, you can upload and display product images for each available language on your website.

It's important for you to have a multi-language website which will display the language of your customers as they visit your store to get more product details before buying. The module helps increase customer interactions with product images through their text and therefore, get you more sales!

*\* “Multi language product images” is compatible with PrestaShop 1.7.x and PrestaShop 8.x*

## III. INSTALLATION

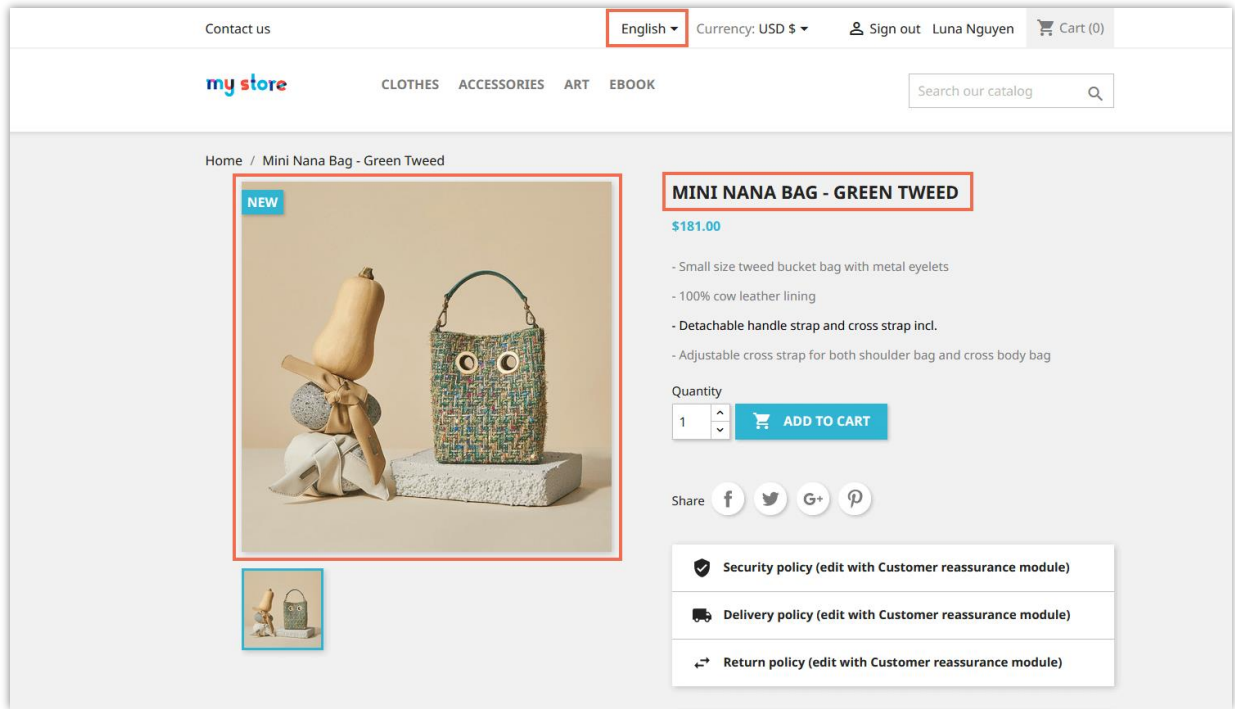
1. Navigate to **“Modules / Modules & Services”**, click on **“Upload a module / Select file”**
2. Select the module file **“ets\_multilangimages.zip”** from your computer then click on **“Open”** to install.

## IV. CONFIGURATION

From your PrestaShop back office dashboard, navigate to **"Catalog"** > **"Products"** page. Open the product you want to add multi language product images.

As default of PrestaShop, when you enable the multi-language mode of your shop, all product images of a product will be kept as same as the images for default language. For example, if your website default language is English, then the product images for French, Italian, Spanish, Romanian, etc. will look the same as product images for English.

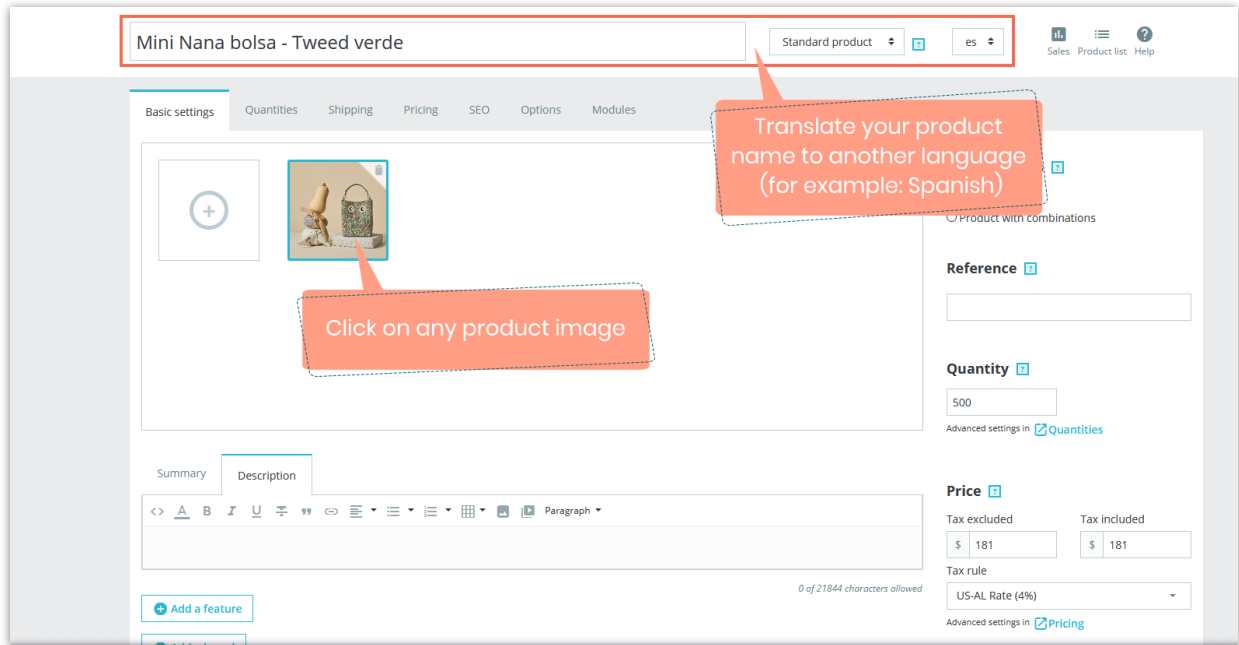

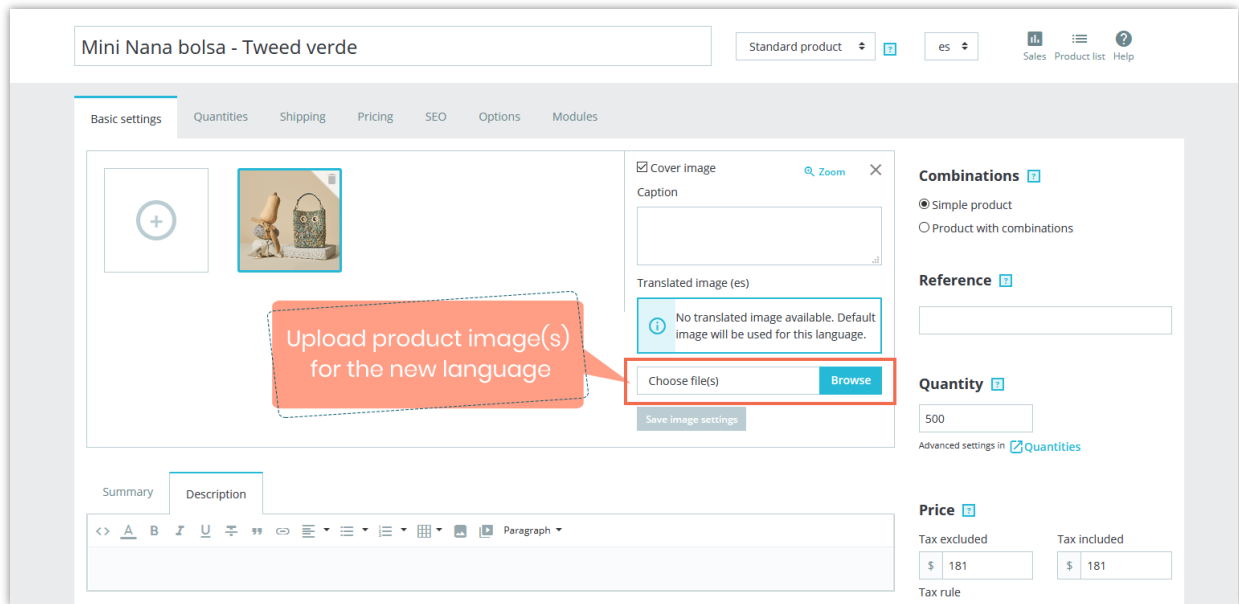
But now, thanks to **“Multi-language product images”** module, you can add different product images for each language available on your website.

Follow our instruction below to add product images for different language:

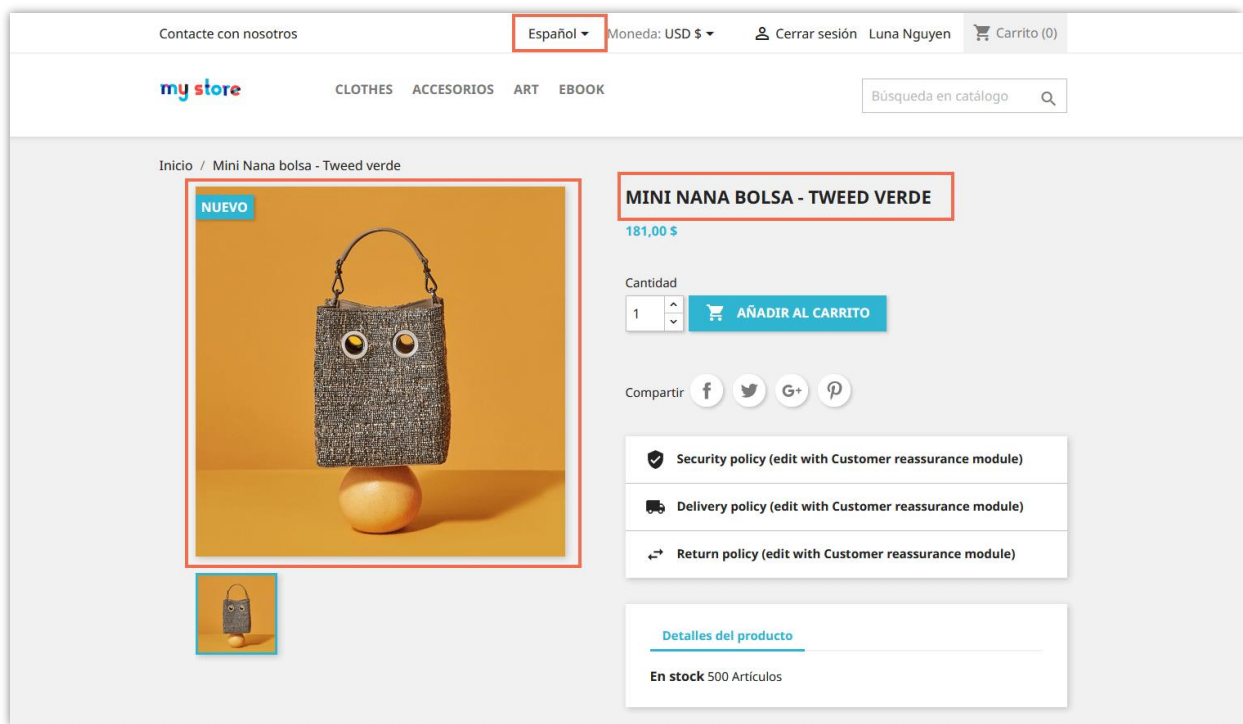
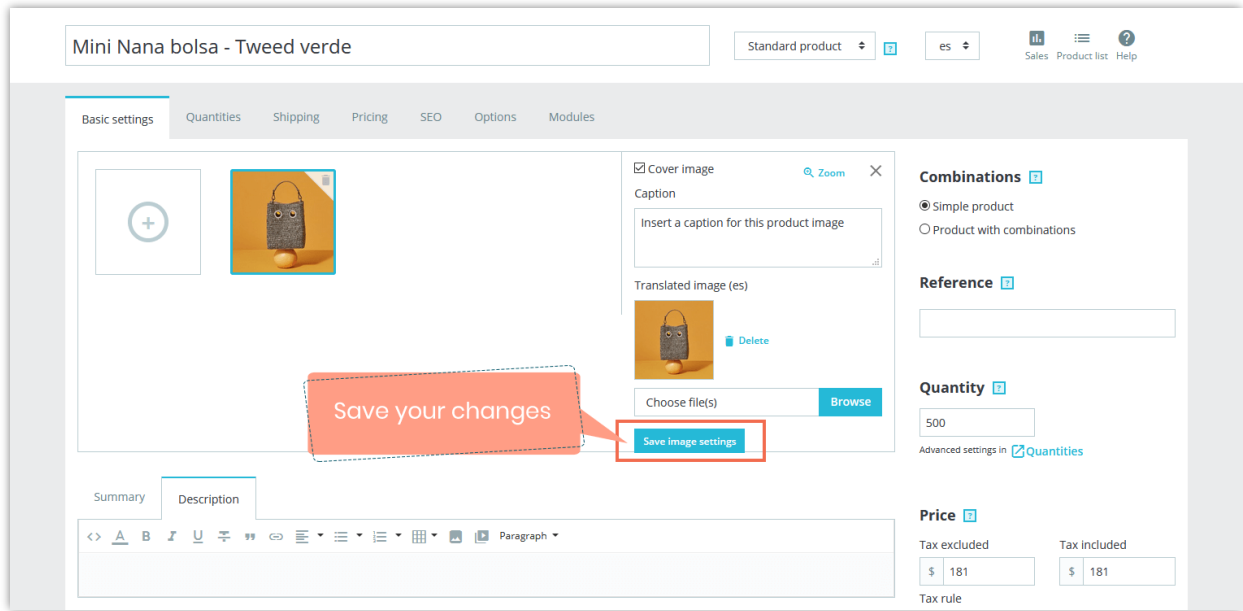
**Step 1:** Change to the language you want to add new product images. Add the translation for product name (optional). Select any available product image.



**Step 2:** On the extra setting panel, click “Browse” button to upload product image(s) for the selected language.



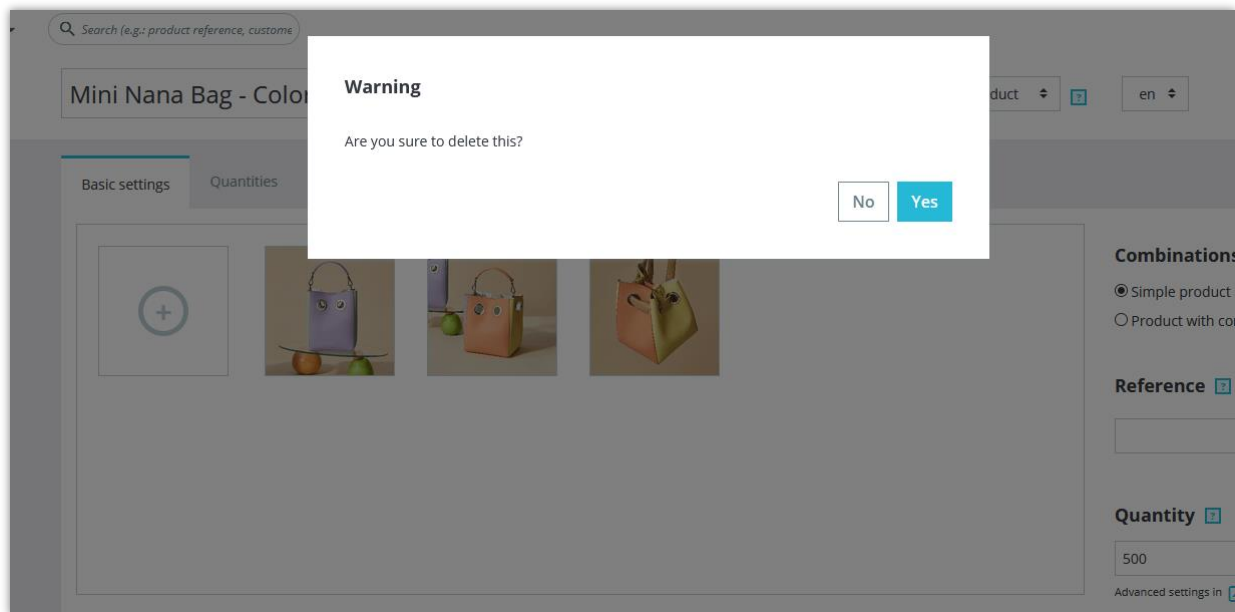
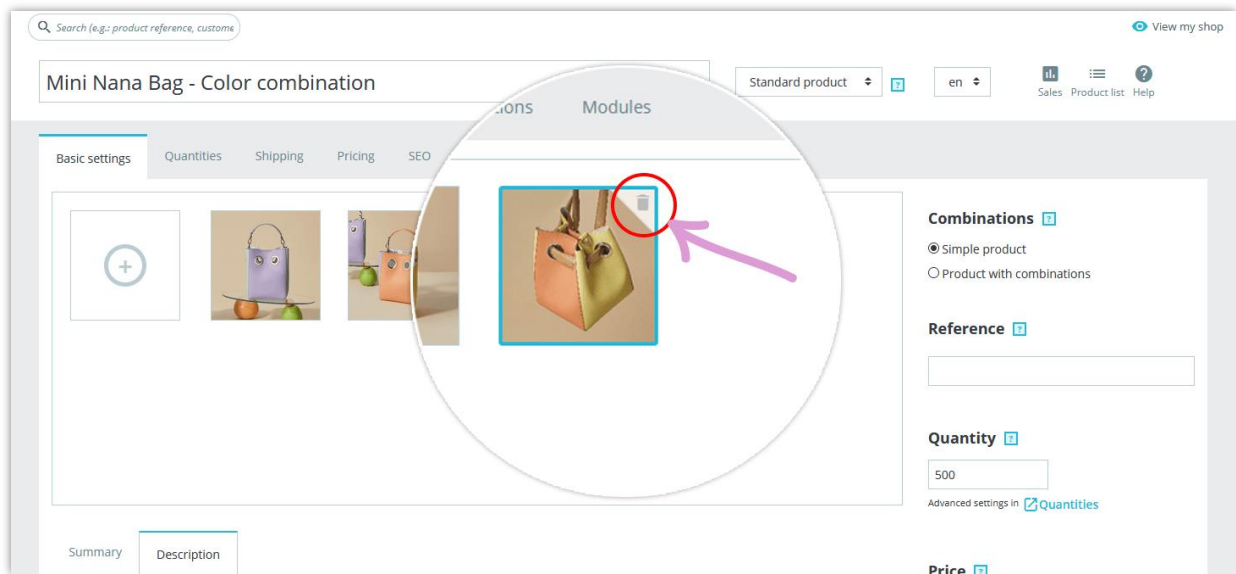
**Step 3:** You may change the product cover image for the select language, zoom image or add a caption for each product image. When you finish, click “Save image settings” button to apply your changes.



### ❖ **Delete multiple product images**

This module allows you to delete all product images in just 1-click. This will apply to all product images of all available languages on your website.

Hover mouse pointer over a product image, you will see a trash can icon appear. Click on this icon to delete all product images.



Remember to click **“Save”** to apply your changes.
